

GEOMETRIC PAIRS DESCRIPTION AND GAME



User's Guide

A4 GEOMETRIC PAIRS

This is a printable game that helps to become familiar with various spatial forms and shapes. When you managed to find the pairs you can build the shapes and hold them in your hands. The idea of the game is to pair up the two-dimensional figures with the spatial forms you would be able to make from them such as a pyramid, a prism and the others. Are you already familiar with them? Great! Then it's time to build them as well according to your imagination!

YOU NEED THE FOLLOWING TO PREPARE THE GAME



- 8 sheets of paper size A4
- printer



- · a pair of scissors
- glue
- 1_ Print the 4 pages below and cut them in half at the center along the broken lines.
- 2_ Then shuffle the 8 smaller sheets and place them next to each other.
- 3_ Try to pair up the figure with the two-dimensional figure that make up its sides.
- **4_** If you found all of them you can start building the figures.
- **5**_ Print the last 4 pages and cut the figures out along the continuous line.
- **6_** Broken lines mark the place where the sheet has to be folded, the striped patterns mark the places where you need to glue them.
- 7_ You may lay the figure and color it as well or you may paint patterns on it.
- 8_ Later on you can join it with the A4 building block game described in the first assignment.
- **9_** When you are ready with coloring or the patterns you can start to join the parts. Glue the handles lightly marked with striped zones and construct the shape.

It is ready! Enjoy it and have fun!
